



### **Development of the DKG Certification Program**

- There are numerous initiatives/projects at European level to ensure and improve the quality of cancer care.
- Through our engagement, we want to actively shape the structures, processes and

standards of the EU, and ensure that our centers and their work are recognized and thus

contribute to improving the quality of oncological care in Europe.

## **European Cancer Cenetre Certification Program (ECC)**

#### Foundation:

The ECC Program is based on the experience, results and core elements of the DKG certification program and

takes country-specific aspects into account.

### **Objectives of the ECC Program**:

- 1. ensure and establish unified structures, standards and processes for tumour-specific oncological care throughout Europe;
- build-up a pan-European database -> to make quality of cancer care measurable, transparent and comparable on a European scale;
- 3. reduce differences and improve quality of cancer care in the European region.





## Implementation of ECC Program by ...

... "translating" the DKG certification program into English, i.e.

- All documents are translated, published and updated in English (<u>www.ecc-cert.org</u>)
- Creation of a country-specific <u>equivalence table</u> to translate "German requirements" to national requirements (e.g. specialist training, oncology nurse)
- Audits are conducted in English and at least one auditor should speak the national language
- Close co-operation with national oncology institutes in countries where ECC certification is to be introduced nationwide (e.g. Switzerland OncoSuisse, Luxembourg INC)
- Establishment of an annual European Cancer Centres Certification Commission meeting



## **ECC Certification Commission**



Next meeting will be held in November 2023 (online)

#### Tasks among others:

- Identification of countryspecific features
- Processing of questions/comments from the member states
- Identification of new forms of networks: e.g. establishment of transnational centres
- Initiation of health service research projects




### **EU-financed projects: Joint Actions**



- DKG has been involved in EU projects since 2014
- Concept of Comprehensive Cancer Care Networks (CCCNs) was developed in the scope of European Commission financed "Joint Actions"
- During JA iPAAC and currently in JA CraNE , both times under the leadership of DKG, practical instruments for the establishment of CCCNs are being developed and implemented




## **Comprehensive Cancer Care Networks (CCCNs)**

"...to develop evidence-based guidelines for prevention, screening and diagnosis of colorectal cancer, together with a quality assurance scheme covering the entire care pathway."

**Initiatives of the European Commission:** 

European Commission Initiative on Breast Cancer (ECIBC, since 2014) & Initiative on Colorectal Cancer (ECICC, since 2022)

- A pilot study to test the certification process and ECIBC quality criteria is currently underway.
- OnkoZert participates as a certification body
- Charité participates as pilot breast cancer centre
- OnkoZert also coordinates the pilot study at the LSOC in Wroclaw
- <u>Our goal</u>: DKG/ECC certificate enables certified Breast Cancer Centres to get the ECIBC certificate without (much) extra effort.
